Mmm, news about my project. I installed a perennial garden in spring of 2018, adding a few annuals for pops of color. I've been involved in the Stitzer Park Project Committee since 2001 and this seemed a natural way to go to beautify the park. I added a bench in memory of my parents who spent many summers here.

Nancy Ashmore helped me and between us we planted a Prairiefire Crabapple tree, a dwarf burning bush, 2 Weigelia, a hydrangea, a potentilla, a dwarf lilac, 2 spirea and an unidentified shrub from the MG plant sale! Other perennials include geranium, daylily, coral bells, grasses, brunnera, sedum, and asiatic lilies.

I weed whenever I go up there with my grandchildren and eventually would like to add an area of hostas under the trees by the entrance to the walking trail.
